



# **School Uniform Guide**

## **2018 – 2019**

## School Uniform:

This guide is to help parents and students to understand our school uniform.



- **Blazer:** – All students must wear the school blazer with the school badge.
- **Jumper:** – All students must wear the black school v-neck jumper with the school badge.
- **Shirt/Blouse:** – All students must wear a blue collared shirt or blouse tucked into trousers or skirt. As the school tie is clip on, it is essential a child can fasten the top button.
- **Tie:** – All students must wear the school tie. There are different ties for students in Key Stage 3 and 4.
- **Trousers:** - As of this year the only trousers we are endorsing are those available from the Crested Schoolwear Centre in Cannock. Trousers purchased from elsewhere may not be suitable and parents may be asked to replace these. All students must wear black tailored trousers. Unacceptable trousers include skinny trousers, denim, stretchy material, large zips or studs. Straight legged trousers must be loose on the ankle.
- **Skirts:** – This must be a black tailored formal skirt of knee length. Skirts made of a stretchy material are not allowed.
- **Socks** – These must be plain black.
- **Tights** – These must be plain black

## Shoes:

All students must wear sensible plain black polishable shoes with no branding. Leather trainers, canvas style shoes or pumps of any variety are not allowed. Sports leisure brands such as Converse, Nike, Adidas, Vans, Lonsdale etc are not acceptable.

## Hairstyles:

Extreme hairstyles are not permitted such as cuts below Number 1, unnatural colour dyeing or tramlines.

## Jewellery and Accessories:

All items of jewellery must be small and discreet. One watch, one ring and one pair of stud earrings are allowed. On health and safety grounds, no other piercings or jewellery is allowed. Inappropriate jewellery will be confiscated. Other items such as wide belts, patterned tights and large hair accessories must not be worn.

## Make-up:

Make-up and nail polish of any kind are not allowed at Key Stage 3. At KS4 a small amount of make-up is acceptable but heavy use will need to be removed. Clear or neutral nail polish is allowed.

## PE Kit:

As a Sports College we believe that a high quality PE Kit is very important. All items of the PE Kit have the school badge and Sports College logo on them.



- **Polo Shirt and shorts** – All students must wear a royal blue school tee shirt with royal blue school shorts. Boys' shorts are shadow striped football shorts,
- **Fleece or Multipurpose top:** Girls need a royal blue school fleece and boys need a royal blue multipurpose top
- **Tracksuit Trousers:** If students wish to wear tracksuit trousers these must be black with the school badge on them.
- **Socks:** All students need royal blue school sport socks.
